

ADMISSIONS INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in Carolina Collaborative Prep (CCP). We are proud of our program and are excited for the opportunity to work with your family in the coming years.

CCP is open to students in grades 3-12 and has a rolling admissions policy, accepting applications throughout the year (as space is available). Our students have high potential but are struggling with learning differences that interfere with their ability to reach their full potential in a larger setting. Our admissions goal is to determine, not only that we are an educational fit for your child, but also a fit for their social and emotional needs as well.

Although no formal diagnosis is required, if your child has one, we ask that a copy be included with the application. Our students have average or above average intelligence as determined in a psychological and/or educational assessment performed by a licensed psychologist. They can follow verbal instructions and work within a small group setting. Unfortunately, we are not able to serve children whose learning difficulties are the result of primary emotional or behavioral problems/diagnoses. Our student population is generally comprised of those diagnosed with Dyslexia, Learning Disabilities in reading or math, Mild Intellectual Disabilities, Autism, ADD/ADHD, Auditory and Sensory Processing Disorder, Anxiety, Visual Impairment and/or other various learning differences.

The common thread among our students is that their learning styles all benefit from a smaller classroom environment and a multi-sensory approach.

Fees

One-time fees:

Application Fee: \$150.00*

Assessment Fee: \$250.00*

Contract Deposit: \$1,500.00**

*The non-refundable Application Fee & non-refundable Assessment Fee are due at the time the application is submitted.

**The non-refundable Contract Deposit is due (along with the signed contract) within ten (10) dates of issuance. This will guarantee your child's enrollment and will hold your child's place. This deposit will be applied in full towards your tuition for the academic year.

The balance, after making the initial deposit, will be due in 10 equal payments, beginning August 15th and will be fully paid on May 15th.

Tuition

Tuition for the 2022 – 2023 school year is as follows:

Lower Academy, Grades 3 – 5 Full Time - \$20,500

Middle & Upper Academy, Grades 6 - 12 Full Time - \$25,000, Part Time - \$20,500

Hands On Fridays Friday Only \$5,000

Homeschool Support Mon -Thurs \$3,500



APPLICATION PROCESS

To ensure that Carolina Collaborative Prep can properly accommodate your child, applicants are asked to follow the steps below:

- Step 1: **Inquiry:** Either complete and submit the New Student Inquiry Form online (or via phone interview).
- Step 2: **Tour:** Meet with a member of the teaching staff for a personalized tour of the school.
- Step 3: **Application:** Submit Application, and required documentation, along with a non-refundable application fee of \$150 and the non-refundable Assessment Fee of \$250 at the time you submit the application.
- Step 4: **Interview and informal educational assessments**: Our teaching staff will contact you to schedule an interview with your child. After an ice breaker activity, informal assessments in reading comprehension, fluency, vocabulary, writing, and math may be administered as time allows. Follow-up assessments will be administered prior to your child's first day of attendance. Please note that we will do everything within our power to put them at ease and make it as stress-free as possible.
- Step 5: **Approval decision:** Once approval has been granted, a non-refundable deposit of \$1,500 is due at the time your child is accepted. We allow for ten (10) days of issuance, for you to return the completed contract and deposit. Enrollment becomes effective once you submit the contract and the non-refundable deposit. The deposit will be applied to the total fee for the upcoming academic year. The balance, after making the initial deposit, will be due in 10 equal payments, beginning August 15th and will be fully paid on May 15th.
